**11.** Specify the reason(s), if the company has failed to spend two per cent of the average net profit as per section 135(5).

The Company continued with its activities of providing 'boring' facilities in identified areas to enable the population (beneficiaries) of those respective areas to

receive water which could alleviate their challenges of water supply required for drinking, washing and sanitation purposes. Towards the second half of the year under consideration the Company decided to adopt a village - Mandwa ("Project -Mandwa"), located near Nagpur (where company's registered office is situate) and for that purposes identified and appointed an eligible implementing agency, by the name - "Niramaya Bahu Uddeshiya Seva Sanstha, Nagpur, which is duly approved for undertaking CSR projects as per the relevant provisions of the Companies Act, having CSR registered number: CSR00023675 and disbursed them Rs.5,00,000/- for initiating the activities, like survey and identifying the precise requirements (gaps) in terms of sanitation, power, education, transport connectivity, livelihood creation and women empowerment, so that a well-planned action plan can be devised and acted upon to get maximum benefit from the CSR spending. The spending thereon was on revenue expenses and no asset got created before the end of FY22. Further there was still an amount of Rs.10,46,000/- to be spent for the current financial year (FY22) as per the requirements of the Companies Act. The Company therefore opened an "RWSIPL - Unspent CSR A/C - FY 2021-22" with HDFC Bank, [Account No.:50200068052108] and an amount of Rs.10,50,000/- was transferred within the timelines prescribed by the provisions of section 135 of the Companies Act. The total unspent amount will be spent on this on-going project - "Project Mandwa" in coming years but the not later than FY2024-25 as is mandated by the provisions of the Companies Act.
